Give a red rose and a book, on Sant Jordi, on Saint George's Day, on April the 23rd.

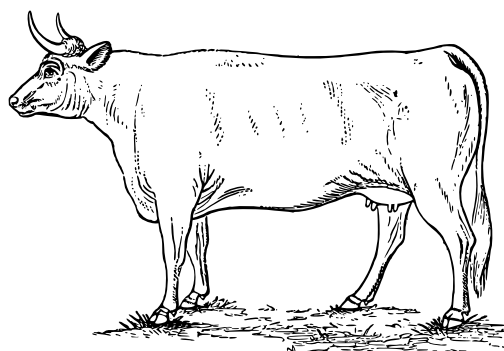

- grew from the blood and was pink.



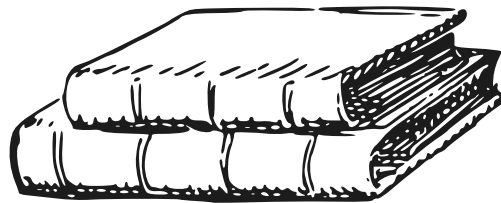
5. On Saint George's Day in Barcelona, you can smell...
